Rules

- 1 The Organising Committee does not accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, ground or any other person or property whatsoever.
- 2 Owners entering their horses do so entirely at their own risk, and it is a condition of entry that no liability whatsoever other than the liability for the refund of entry fees in the event of the abandonment of the competition.
- 3 In all classes the decision of the judges is final.
- 4 Any Competitor may be eliminated at the discretion of the judges for excessive use of whips or spurs.
- 5 All riders must wear hats to standard PAS015, BSEN 1384, ASTM F1163 or equivalent.
- 6 The Organising Committee reserve the right to refuse entries without giving a reason.
- 7 The owner of any animal thought to be suffering from an infectious or contagious disease will be asked to remove it from the showground.
- 8 Any competitor or spectator acting in a manner likely to be offensive to any competitor or spectator will be asked to leave the showground.
- 9 Objections must be lodged at the Secretary's box within 30 minutes of the end of the class, and must be accompanied by £20 which will be refunded in the event of the objection being upheld.
- 10 The Organising Committee reserve the right to cancel or alter any class without giving a reason.
- 11 Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times.
- 12 Galloping around the showground is forbidden.
- 13 No horse or pony under 4yrs old may compete in ridden classes.
- 14 No Stallion to be handled/ridden by anyone under 16yrs old.
- 15 The organisers cannot be held responsible for any clashes of classes.

Health and Safety - The organisers of the show have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the officials and stewards.
