Grid Reference SX 710585**

**A38 Westbound** leave at Wrangaton slip road and turn left at top. At Kitterford Cross turn left. Into Avonwick and turn left at T junction.

**A38 Eastbound** Leave at Woodpecker junction (signposted South Brent Totnes and Avonwick) at the Shell petrol station. Turn right signed Avonwick and follow road to Avonwick.

At Avonwick the show will be clearly signposted.

## HEALTH & SAFETY STATEMENT

The Organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present.  
For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid accidents occurring and must at all times obey the instructions of the Organisers and Stewards.

## RULES AND GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The judge's decision will be final.
2. Hard hats MUST be worn at all times when mounted.
3. Competitors on the lead rein are NOT permitted to enter ANY other classes off the lead rein.
4. Horse & Rider combinations competing in Ring 4 are NOT eligible to jump in Leading Rein or Minimus Jumping.
5. Leading rein must be attached to noseband or halter NOT to bit.
6. It is the competitor's responsibility not to enter two classes which appear likely to clash. In the event, the competitor must decide which class to enter as classes cannot be held up indefinitely and no refunds will be made.
7. NO whips or spurs in Gymkhana events.
8. In the event of an objection, a £10 deposit must be paid to the Secretary within 30 minutes of the end of the class.
9. The Committee reserves the right to restrict entries.
10. The Committee reserves the right to cancel any event or modify the schedule.
11. All dogs MUST be KEPT on LEADS.
12. NO galloping allowed outside the rings.
13. The Show Organisers and the Land Owners or Tenants cannot be held responsible for any accident, damage, injury or loss to any competitor, visitor, vehicle or animal.
14. Trophies at all times remain the property of Diptford Show.
15. Engraving of Trophies is the responsibility of the winner.
16. Trophies won in 2009 must be returned to the Show Secretary by 15 May 2010.
17. No parking at the ringside except for disabled drivers displaying badges.
