HOW TO FIND US (FROM TAVISTOCK)

From Bedford Square in Tavistock take the second exit on the first Mini roundabout followed by the second exit on the second mini roundabout (go up hill towards Whitchurch). Take second turning on left (Down Road) and continue on this road for a mile (Passing Tavistock Golf Club) to Warrens Cross and turn right there. Continue across Plaister Down for half a mile, take first left. Monkswell field is on right just before cattlegrid.

RULES OF THE SHOW

- 1 The Judges decision is final
- 2 Hats to approved Pony Club standard must be worn at all times when mounted.
- 3 No galloping on the field
- 4 Dogs to be kept on leads
- 5 In classes where age restrictions apply a competitor's age is as on the day of the show
- 6 In the gymkhana where competitors are being led, assistance is only allowed in the control of the pony and not to assist the rider in the tasks involved with the game.
- 7 All competitors compete at their own risk. Neither the organisers nor any person acting on their behalf will be liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, vehicles and their contents and accessories, or any other person or property whatsoever. The organiser has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all the officials and stewards.

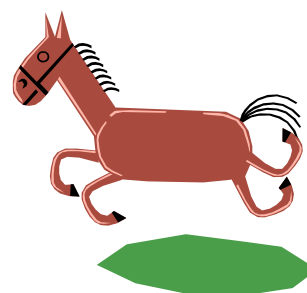

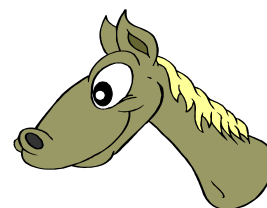
