6	Open	0.90m (2'11" approx) Level 3
7	Open	1.00m (3'3" approx) Level 4

Dressage Times: Telephone 01548 580549 Thurs 11th June 7-9pm. Times will also be available on The Pony Club website www.pcuk.org click on find a branch, then click on SW then South Pool.

Cross-country – classes 3 to 7 will be timed. Competitors will be penalised for going faster than the optimum time. Only competitors in Class 7 will be penalised for exceeding optimum time.

Novice classes will be designed to encourage the novice combination, with 'L' fence options.

Conditions of Entry: This event will be run under Pony Club Eventing Rules 2009.

Please note:

1) A horse/pony may only compete in one class. Stallions only allowed with DC or organiser's permission & must wear identifying disc on bridle in the interest of safety. A rider may ride up to 2 different horses.

2) All competitors MUST wear an approved safety hat to one of the following standards: PAS 015 1998, EN 1384 1996, BS EN 1384 1997 with BSI kitemark, Snell E2001 with official Snell label & number, AS/NZS 3838 1998, AS/NZS 3838 2003. Hats must be presented for tagging when collecting numbers. A JOCKEY SKULL CAP WITH NO FIXED PEAK FOR LEVEL 3 & OVER.

- 3) Body protectors are essential for all riders in the cross-country phase & are recommended for show jumping. Riders wearing the Wool Wear body cage EXO must lodge a key with the event organiser when they collect their number.
 Medical armbands are compulsory for Pony Club members for XC & show jumping, all other competitors are strongly advised to wear a medical armband, (available for sale on day of competition)
- 4) Jewellery is not allowed.
- 5) Tack will be inspected at each phase to ensure compliance with rules & safety.
- 6) Any PC member wishing to wear spurs must carry a card signed by their DC granting permission unless they have attained their B Test.
- 7) Dogs may only be brought to the venue if they have been wormed regularly as the land is used for grazing sheep, & must be kept on a short lead at all times.

*The course will be available for walking from 3pm on Saturday 13th June
 Please bring sufficient water supplies, no standpipe in horsebox park.*
