**DIRECTIONS TO SHOWGROUND
FROM TOTNES**

Take the A381 to Kingsbridge
The field will be signposted on the left just before Stumpy Post roundabout

FROM PLYMOUTH/MODBURY

Take the A379 towards Kingsbridge
After passing through Churchstow, carry straight on at Palegate Cross and Sorley Cross,
towards Totnes.
The field will be signposted on the right just after Stumpy Post Cross roundabout

**IMPORTANT – PLEASE PARK IN SHOW FIELD - NOT ON THE LANE
PLEASE KEEP THE FIELD GATE SHUT**

RULES

APPROVED PROTECTIVE HATS (PAS015, EN1384,ASTM F1163) AND BLACK OR BROWN BOOTS MUST BE WORN CORRECTLY AT ALL TIMES WHILE MOUNTED.

A BODY PROTECTOR IS ADVISED FOR SHOW JUMPING, JACKETS MUST BE WORN

NO HORSE OR PONY MAY BE ENTERED FOR MORE THAN 3 JUMPING CLASSES

SHOWJUMPING will be held under BSJA rules – Competitors in Ring 1 show jumping may not jump the same horse in Ring 2 show jumping classes except for 'horse and hound'

LEADING REINS must be attached to the noseband and not to the bit.

RIDER'S AGE will be taken as on the day of the show.

OBJECTIONS must be lodged with the Secretary immediately after the event with a deposit of £10. This will be refunded if the objection is upheld.

DOGS must be kept on SHORT LEADS and under control at all times. Loose dogs may be impounded and only released after a £1 donation to Riding for the Disabled charity.

The committee reserve the right to ALTER OR CANCEL any classes.

The Committee reserve the right to CLOSE CLASSES if they consider them to be full. Early entry is therefore advisable.

THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL.

The COMMITTEE and the LANDOWNER WILL NOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE for any LOSS, ACCIDENT OR DAMAGE which may occur to, involve or be caused to any exhibit, competitor, spectator and/or any other person, animal or vehicle on the Showground or in the vicinity and it shall be a condition of entry that each competitor and spectator shall hold the Committee and landowners blameless and indemnify them from any legal proceedings ensuing from any such damage.
