2. The judge will ride at their own discretion without giving an explanation.
3. The committee has the right to refuse any entries without giving a reason.
4. Any animal that kicks must wear a red ribbon on its tail.
5. No horse/pony under the age of four to be ridden.
6. All mounted competitors must wear a suitable hat whilst mounted and is responsible for providing one.
7. Lead reins must be attached to the noseband.
8. No refunds for classes that clash.
9. Any objections must be made as soon as possible at the secretary's tent. A £20 deposit will be required and this will be refunded if the complaint is upheld.
10. The Judges decision is final

## **Directions to showground**

The showground is located (as last year) just off the A379 Modbury to Yealmpton road.

From Exeter / Newton Abbot: Take the A38 heading towards Plymouth, then take the Modbury / Wrangaton / Ivybridge Railway Station turning. Turn immediately left at top of slip road, then follow road to “give way” sign at major crossroad and turn right heading towards Ermington. Follow road (past Ermington) until next “give way” sign at main road (A379) and turn right. Follow the A379 until you pass a turning on your left to Holbeton. The Showground is about 100 yards on your right hand side just after the Holbeton turning.

From Plymouth: Take the A379 heading towards Modbury. Go through Yealmpton and you will find the Show Ground sign posted on the left after about 2 miles just before the Holbeton turning.
