Please supervise small children at all times and do not leave babies in pushchairs unattended, or enter horse collecting area with pushchairs, or dogs etc.

RULES

1. Judge's Decision is final. Complaints to be lodged to the secretary with £15 deposit returned if complaint is upheld.
2. All riders mounted and those handling young stock must wear suitable protective head and foot wear.
3. No jewellery other than wedding ring to be worn.
4. Ages as attained on day of show, No child under 4yrs to be mounted.
5. The organisers/BDRC accept no responsibility/liability for any accident or loss, however caused, in connection with this event.
6. The organisers BDRC have the discretion to cancel or postpone the event or alter any class. They reserve the right to refuse any entry.
7. Competitors will be eliminated for excessive use of the whip or spurs (NB rule 1) and banned from the show ground.
8. A valid certificate of insurance must be produced on entry of any stallion over 2yrs old. No junior will be eligible to compete on a stallion.
9. All dogs to be kept on leads at all times. Clean up after your dog please.
10. No horse or pony under 4yrs to be ridden on the show ground, horse must be suitable for the rider.
11. No galloping or lunging on the field. All exercising to be carried out having regard to the safety of others.
12. In a Two Phase jumping competition, both phases of the competition are run without interruption, the finishing line for the first phase is the starting line for the second phase. The first phase is not against the clock; the second phase will be timed and is against the clock. The first phase will be over a course of 7 to 9 obstacles and the second phase will be over 4 to 6 obstacles. In the case of a competitor

having penalties in the first round they will be halted by the judge ringing the bell after they have jumped the final obstacle in the first phase. If a competitor has no penalties in the first phase they will immediately continue onto the second phase.

The Tarka and the Taw & Torridge Qualifiers

The first 6 places (disregarding those who have already qualified) in the Tarka Qualifier and the Taw and Torridge Qualifier qualify for The Tarka Trophy final and The Taw and Torridge Final respectively, both held at North Devon Show on August 4th 2010

The Tarka Qualifier is open to ponies 14.2hh and under and riders to be 16 years or under on the day of the show.

The Taw & Torridge Qualifier is open to horses over 14.2hh and riders of any age

Riders may not enter both the Tarka and the Taw & Torridge.

The classes are open to residents from any of the parishes in North Devon and Torridge District Council areas

If the show jumping classes in ring 2 are busy we will run them as Two Phase (see rule 12), to minimise disruption to show classes and avoid time wasted waiting for competitors who are competing in other rings.
